support dairy initiatives across the country, such as the one awarded to **College Aggies Online**. This nationwide educational and scholarship competition, hosted by the Animal Agriculture Alliance, trains college students to become effective communicators and advocates for animal agriculture.

It's aim is to strengthen public trust by equipping students with accurate science-based information through a nine-week program. In 2025, the program included 265 participants who shared nearly 1,670 informative social media posts about agriculture. Eight collegiate clubs competed and hosted 22 campus and community events, reaching nearly 8,200 people in person.
